Art First, London moved out of the St Mary's Walk premises in Lambeth during August 2024, because the building is to be re-developed as offices. I decided to bring gallery life to an end in terms of monthly exhibitions and regular art fairs and instead to continue Art First activities as an Art Consultancy, working from a private office on particular projects with gallery artists - from commissions to online exhibitions or shows in guest premises, overseeing publications, conducting studio visits, art installation advice and so on.

A significant development is that <u>Simon Lewty</u> appointed me to be his Artistic Executor in his Will, following his death shortly after his 80th birthday in late 2021. It has taken a long time to sort out his Estate but it has now been agreed that as he directed, funds are to be given to two Charities - the Artists' Benevolent General Institution and a portion to Refuge. An amount has been allocated to Art First for the purposes of setting up a catalogue raisonné of the remaining 300 works and to create a stand - alone website that will serve to protect and ensure his significant and fascinating legacy.



This task will be a great honour as well as a pleasure to undertake, and during the next few years I shall dedicate a great deal of time to it. I have also begun a new Instagram account for Simon Lewty's Estate. In London works can be seen at the Victoria & Albert Museum, Arts Council England and the British Museum, where three recent works by Lewty have been added to their collection.
